Forests Ecosystem Services

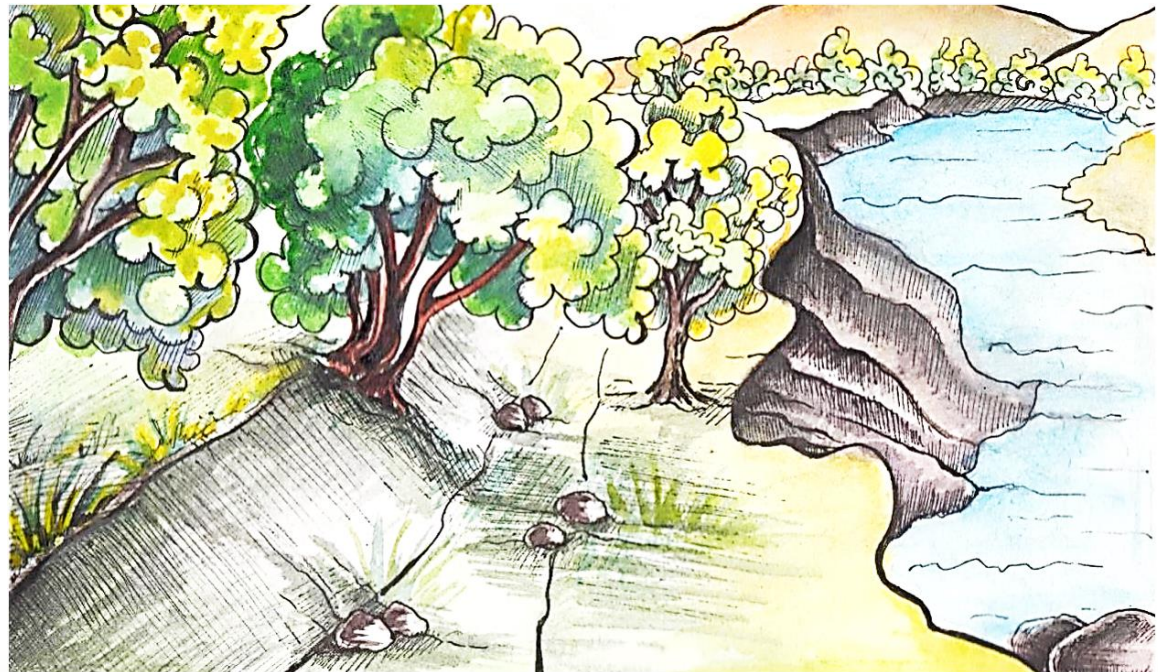
- Nutrient cycling and soil formation

Forest Management as a DRR strategy

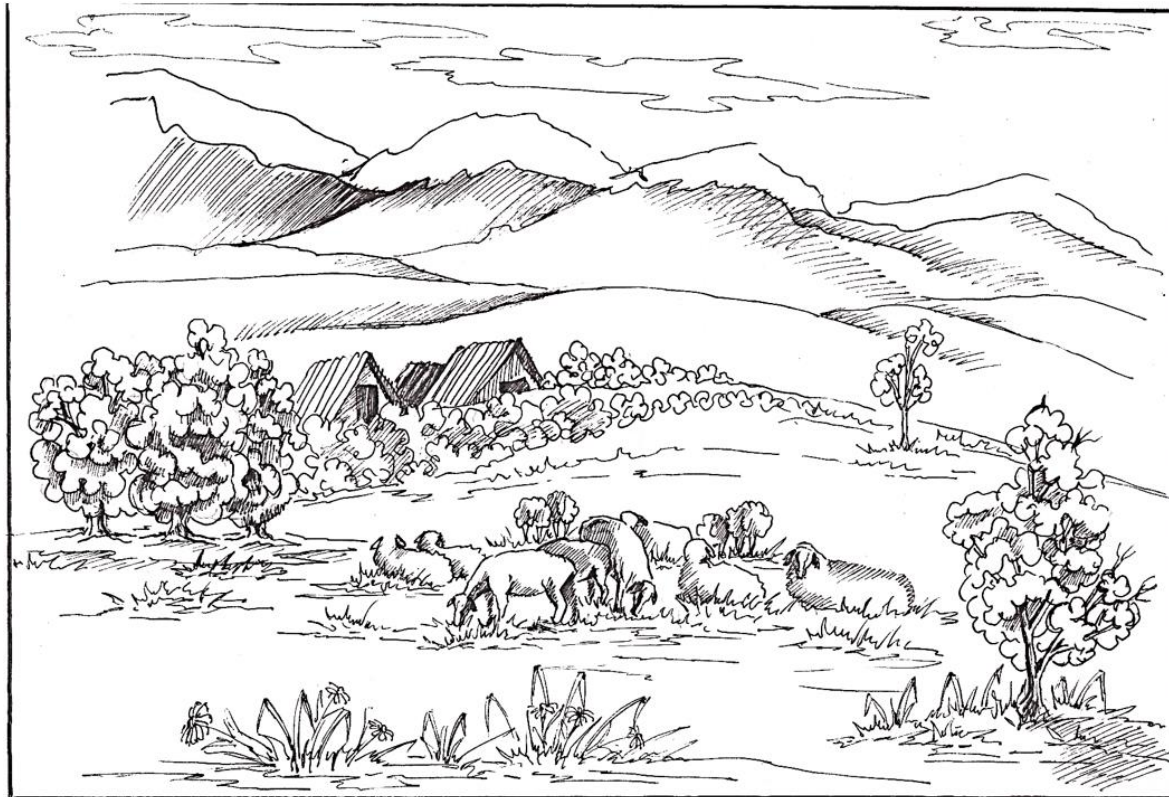
Forests provide many ecosystem services and help protect the village from various disasters, such as:
